



DACA RENEWAL DOCUMENTATION CHECKLIST

Who is eligible to renew DACA?

If you have DACA and your DACA expires between **now** and **March 5, 2018**, you can submit your application for a two-year renewal by **October 5, 2017**. After **October 5, 2017**, USCIS will no longer accept any renewal applications.

If your DACA expires **March 6, 2018, or later**, you will not be able to apply for renewal.

No new DACA applications will be accepted after September 5, 2017.

ALL APPLICANTS MUST SEND TO USCIS FOR RENEWAL:

_____ Three completed, dated and signed forms: **I-821-D, I-765 and I-765WS** (which can be downloaded from the FORMS section of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service site: www.uscis.gov.) Leave blank Part 3 in form I-1821-D. Don't use old versions of these forms, as they will be rejected. Download the most current version from the USCIS website.

_____ Copy of current Employment Authorization Card (both sides)

_____ Copies of approval notices (Form I-797) of prior application of forms I-821-D and I-765

_____ Personal check or money order payable to "US DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY" for \$495.00

_____ Two passport-size (2 x 2), color photographs

APPLICANTS WITH A CONVICTION OF ANY KIND (including misdemeanors and traffic offenses)

Please obtain a certificate of "final disposition" from the court where you were convicted or paid a fine. You should consult an attorney regarding how to proceed.

APPLICANTS WITH A FINAL ORDER OF DEPORTATION OR IN REMOVAL PROCEEDINGS

_____ Copy of Immigration Judge order and any documentation on your immigration case. Please consult an attorney before submitting your application.
